Dear Parents,

YEAR 11 FINAL REPORT

Please be advised that your child’s Year 11 Final Report, which, based on current performance and attitudinal information, provides an indication as to the final outcomes your child could expect in August assuming they continue working in a similar fashion, has now been uploaded to the ‘Documents’ area of EduLink One. In order to access the Final Report document, you will need to log in to EduLink One using your parental log-in details. There are four key pieces of information contained within the report, as follows:

1. The **Tutor Comment** which provides a holistic snapshot of the role your child has played within the tutor group as well as their whole-school engagement and participation.
2. The Spring **Effort Grade**, which reflects the attitude displayed by your child in the stated subject area (the effort scale can be viewed on the school website in the ‘Assessment and Progress’ area).
3. The Spring **‘On Track for’ Grade**, which suggests the grade that a student should achieve at the end of the course, if they continue working in a similar fashion to that observed by staff to date.
4. The Autumn **Mock** and **‘On Track for’ Grades** already reported to you in December 2025.

Please note that the ‘On Track for’ Grades for Art, Ceramics and Photography are not yet reflective of the results of the exams which took place last month.

Furthermore, to supplement this information, your child’s average CATs test score is also included. Ordinarily, we have used KS2 Average Scores to derive an expected attainment pathway. As this year group were unable to sit these assessments at the end of KS2, we are using their Year 7 Cognitive Ability Test results to inform our pathway. Please note that due to Covid restrictions and timings of the CAT tests, not all students will have a score. The table below provides an indication of Calthorpe Park School’s expectations and suggests the grade beyond which your child should aim to attain. The table should be used as a guide to indicate the progress that your child is capable of achieving, given their Year 7 starting points. We appreciate that this is not definitive but for the moment this is the most appropriate metric to use.

At the bottom of the Final Report, you will find their record of achievement and behaviour points awarded to your child so far this year. Points are awarded for a range of activities. Achievement points are given to

recognise positive student action within subject areas as well as the wider school context. Behaviour points are given as a result of student negative behaviour ranging from persistent uniform and homework contraventions to unacceptable behaviour towards others.

A percentage attendance figure is provided as well as further information regarding authorised and unauthorised absence. Authorised means there is a valid reason for a student to have missed school. Unauthorised means the school does not know why a student was absent or was unable to give permission for the absence.

Finally, we would recommend spending time with your child discussing this report, reflecting on successes and planning for the future. However, if you have any immediate concerns, please take the opportunity to raise these with the relevant member of staff at the school.
